- Net cash used in investing activities was 416.8 billion yen, due to the outflow related to the acquisition of shares of equity-method affiliates, capital expenditures in overseas businesses and others.
- · As a result, free cash flow was an outflow of 144.4 billion yen.

<Financial Position>

- Net interest-bearing debt increased by 351.7 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 2,254.1 billion yen, mainly due to the free cash outflow, dividend payments and share repurchases and others.
- Equity attributable to owners of the parent increased by 252.5 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 3,712.2 billion yen, due to an increase in the retained earnings from net profit accumulation and the increase in foreign currency translation adjustments resulting from the depreciation of the Japanese yen.
- · As a result, net DE ratio stood at 0.61 times.
